Notes:

Each project requires a reflection to demonstrate the learning process articulated through content vocabulary. In addition to class content vocabulary, students should use 6-traits, writing process, reading comprehension, instructional strategies, and technology to articulate the learning process and objective. This vocabulary should be used in the project, the reflection, and in the oral presentation. **The reflection must also include 2-3 reflection questions tailored specifically to each project.**
